- **2. SANCTION** The general playing and tournament rules of the BTBA will govern the tournament as Sanctioned by the TBAW (Sanction No.01/23)
- 3. **ELIGIBILITY** All entrants must be members in good standing with their national associations.
- **4. TOURNAMENT MANAGER** The tournament manager will be the Chairman of the TBAW or his duly elected officer. Their decision on all things relating to the tournament will be final, subject to the right of appeal to the TBAW Executive Committee.

#### **5. FORMAT.** QUALIFICATION

6 games, Re-entries 6 games, Desperado Squad 1 game. Turbo – (Cumulative high and low games)

Positions 1-4 in Qualification progress to Final Step 3. Positions 5-8 in Qualification progress to Final Step 2. Positions 9-34 in Qualification progress to Final Step 1 (scores zeroed) Desperado positions 1-4 progress to Final Step 1 Turbo positions 1-2 progress to Final Step 1

#### Final Step 1

32 athletes will play 4 games. Highest 20 positioned athletes progress to Final Stage 2 (scores zeroed)

#### Final Step 2

Positions 5-8 from Qualification, plus highest 20 athletes from Final Step 1. Athletes play 4 games. (scores zeroed)

#### Final Step 3

Positions 1-4 from Qualification, plus highest 12 athletes from Final Step 2. Athletes play 4 games.

Athletes positioned 1-8 progress to Final Step 4 Athletes positioned 9-16 will be ranked 9-16

#### Final Step 4/Round Robin

8 Athletes play a 7 game Round Robin. Pinfall from Final Step 3 carried forward. Bonus pins awarded 20 pins for a win and 10 pins for a draw. Athletes will be ranked 1-8 on total pinfall including bonus.

LADIES- Ladies will receive standard 8 bonus pins per game in all rounds.

**6.DISPUTES** A provisional ball will be rolled if any dispute cannot be quickly resolved. Protests must be lodged with the Tournament Manager within 30 minutes of the infraction and confirmed in writing within 72 hours.

- **7. LANE ETIQUETTE** Slow bowling will not be tolerated. One verbal warning will be given, followed by disqualification if the warning is ignored. No more than 2 lanes courtesy is to be given.
- **8. ALCOHOL** Consumption of alcohol whilst bowling is not permitted.
- **9. DRESS** Suitable bowling attire will be worn. Jeans and sleeveless tops will not be permitted.
