Trials Qualification, Team Wales Qualification and the General Playing Rules of the TBAW are as previously published on the TBAW Website:

This tournament is sanctioned by the TBAW.

This trial will consist of 9 games bowled in one day, changing lanes after every 3 games bowled.

Squad availability will be on a first come first served basis.

The ranking points will be awarded to eligible TBAW players using the current ranking system, as previously published by the TBAW.

In the event of a tie for tournament position, the team with the highest last game will take the higher position. If still tied the second highest game will be used and so on, until the tie is broken.

No re-entry is allowed.

Handicap is based on 80% of 220.
