This trial will consist of 9 games bowled over 1 day, changing lanes after every 3 games. The 9 games will be handicap and prizes allocated on that basis. Individual scratch scores from day 1 will determine the 8 players who progress to the Round Robin on Day 2. The Round Robin carries its own prize fund. One lane pattern will be used on Day 1 and Two patterns laid on alternate lanes during the Round Robin on Day 2.

Squad availability will be on a first come first served basis. Ranking points will be awarded on scratch scores over the initial 9 games, to eligible TBAW players using the current ranking system, as previously published by the TBAW on our website. In the event of a tie for tournament position, the person with the highest last game will take the higher position. If still tied the second highest game will be used and so on until the tie is broken. **No re-entry is allowed.** Handicap is based on 80% of 220.
