This tournament is sanctioned by the TBAW and will be conducted in accordance with the General Playing and Tournament rules of the BTBA together with the following special rules:

Trials Qualification, Team Wales Qualification and the General Playing Rules of the TBAW are as previously published on the TBAW Website: <http://www.tenpinbowling.wales>

This competition will consist of 9 games, bowled on one day, changing lanes every game.

- Squad availability will be on a first come, first served basis.

The ranking points will be awarded to eligible TBAW players using the current ranking system, as previously published by the TBAW.

- In the event of a tie for position, the bowlers in the tied position will ALL get the same points, with any additional positions dropping down a position, for each tied person, in the ranking points
 - Examples:
 - Second place gets 95 points
 - If two bowlers are tied in second place, they both get 95 points
 - Third place points do not get allocated to any other bowler
 - The second/third bowlers get the same points
 - If three bowlers are tied in second place, they ALL get 95 points
 - Third and Fourth place points do not get allocated to any other bowler
 - The second/third/fourth place bowlers get the same points
- Handicap is based on 80% of 220.
- **No re-entry is allowed.**

Counties ONLY

1. The tournament is sanctioned by the TBAW and the General Playing Rules and Tournament Rules of the BTBA will govern this event, together with the following rules.
2. The tournament will be held at Phoenix Bowl on the 22nd & 23rd March The tournament is open to all eligible bowlers
3. Eligibility: -
 - 3.1 **The bowler must be a current TBAW member in good standing.**
 - 3.2 **The bowler must be eligible to hold a British Passport, or have lived continuously in the UK for at least five years.**
 - 3.3 **The bowler must have been born within the boundaries of South Wales Counties; if a Junior, must have been born in Wales, OR**
 - 3.4 **The bowler must have resided within the boundaries for not less than one year at the time of registration. Serving members of H.M. Forces and their dependants shall qualify after a six-month residential period.**

This is a scratch singles tournament with separate male and female sections. The top male and female bowlers in the adult section will be awarded the county shield and each year will have their name engraved on the shield. The shield will be kept on display at Milford Bowl

- a. All bowlers will bowl 9 games.
- b. Games will be bowled during the doubles event at Milford 22nd 23rd March 2025, changing lanes every game.
- c. Bowlers will draw for lanes and starting line-up.
- d. Based on scratch scores, all team selection will be the top 7 males and 7 females in each section, unless disqualified from team selection.
- e. In the event there are insufficient funds to enter any teams for the Adult Inter-County Championships, you will be asked to help contribute towards the lineage costs.
- f. The TBAW reserves the right not to enter teams in any section unless sufficient bowler entries are paid up: Should any team have insufficient entries at the start of the first squad, then paid up bowlers in that section only will be offered a full refund and the opportunity to withdraw.
- g. Dress code: no jeans or sleeveless tops.
- h. Drinking of alcohol is not permitted while bowling. Smoking is not permitted in the centre. Mobile phones are not permitted on the lanes or bowlers' area while bowling.
- i. Failure to produce a current TBAW membership card will incur a £2.00 charge
Squad Time: See attached entry form
Registration is 30 minutes before squad time.
- j. A provisional ball must be rolled if any dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately. Protests must be lodged with the tournament manager within 30 minutes of an infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 72 hours of the game in which the infraction occurred.
- k. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to reject an entry and his decision in all matters, including team selection shall be final subject to appeal to the TBAW.
- l. Bowlers with a current TBAW membership, will automatically be entered into the handicap singles event. You will need to provide your current highest league/tournament average and prizes will be subject to verification.
