This tournament is sanctioned by the TBAW and will be conducted in accordance with the General Playing and Tournament rules of the BTBA together with the following special rules:

This trial will consist of 8 games bowled on 1 squad, changing lanes after every 2 games bowled. Squad availability will be on a first come, first served basis.

In the event of a tie for tournament position, the player with the highest last game will take the higher position. If still tied the second highest game will be used and so on, until the tie is broken. Re-entry is allowed.

No urethane balls are permitted to be used during this event.

This will be played on 2 patterns, one on odd number lanes one on even numbered lanes

Entry into this tournament is deemed acceptance that live streaming and/or other electronic recording devices may be used.

SMOKING / VAPING:

Smoking or Vaping during the block you have entered is strictly not permitted

BALL SURFACE ADJUSTMENTS:

Ball surface changes during the block you have entered is strictly not permitted
